





## MARKET CENTER HAS ALWAYS BEEN THE PLACE TO BE.




### UNIQUE OFFICE SPACES AVAILABLE FOR LEASE

Market Center was built in the early 1880s, and is currently undergoing an extensive renovation to suit today's modern business landscape. One of the few surviving late 19th-century commercial buildings in the oldest part of Denver, it's an eclectic collection of five landmark buildings with fascinating histories of wholesaling fruit, flowers, meat, fish, and bakers' supplies.

The historic Denver landmark offers approximately 121,000 square feet of office and retail space, and close to 85,000 square feet of leasable office space across a total of five floors.

Brimming with character, personality, and an array of original details, each and every tenant space is sure to delight staff, clients, and visitors alike.




## COVETED NEIGHBORHOOD, WORLD-CLASS CITY
